



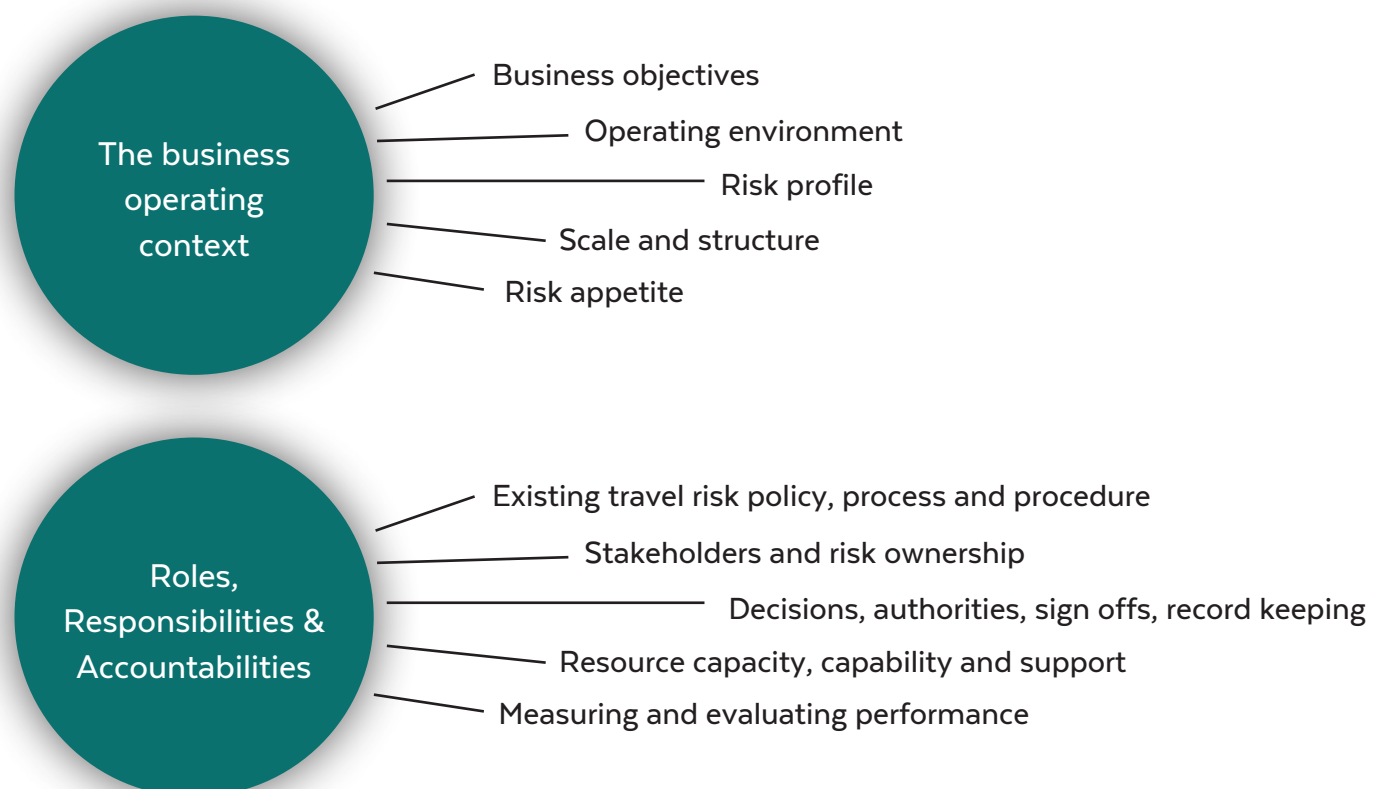
ISO 31030 Travel Risk Management Guidance Company Readiness Assessment

The Standard sets out what is expected of any organisation - large or small and regardless of sector - that requires its staff to travel as part of their duties, whether national or international.
